

MASTER ADDRESS EMERGENCY RESPONSE SHEET

The Independence Police Department Dispatch Center dispatches for both the Emergency Medical Ambulance Service and the Fire Department in Independence. The Independence Police Department's computer system has the ability to store emergency response information for a specific address. If you live in the city limits of Independence and have a specific medical problem or special need, for example; you use a wheelchair - you are hard of hearing - there is a baby monitor being used - you have an existing medical condition that requires special assistance when you call the Ambulance, etc., you may use this form to provide the Police Department with your medical condition or special need.
