

ORDINANCE NO. 4425

An Ordinance Regulating Political Signs

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Independence, Kansas:


Section 1. Section 803.3(a) is amended as follows to read in its entirety:

Section 803.3 Temporary signs: all political signs, real estate signs, garage sale signs, or other signs of a temporary nature for a personal gain shall conform with the following requirements:

- a. No temporary signs of any nature shall be attached to any public utility pole or shall be installed within the right-of-way of a public road or street, provided however, this subsection shall not apply to the placement of political signs during the 45 day period prior to any election and the 2 day period following any such election.
- b. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication in the official city newspaper.
